Missionary Trail Trip 2016

Come with us from April 13th through April 29th 2016, as we journey to China. Accompanied by knowledgeable CSV guides, you will become acquainted with important aspects of missionary history and see and experience CSV's current work in China. You will visit famous Chinese landmarks such as The Great Wall of China and cruise the Yangtze River. You will



travel to areas in which early Lutheran missionaries served, and visit ongoing projects that are the result of these missionaries' labor.

The cost of the trip is based on a minimum of 10 travelers and is \$4,100.00 if paid in full by December 15th, 2015. Trips fully paid after December 15th will be \$4,250.00. A deposit of \$2000.00 is the minimum due by December 15th. The remainder is due on February 10th. Trip costs are based on double occupancy, and include round-trip airfare from Minneapolis and all meals. Visa costs, passport, and incidental tipping are not included. Single travelers add \$750.00.

Trip Itinerary Highlights

- ◇ April 13th: Leave the Twin Cities for Shanghai.
- ◇ April 14th: Arrive Shanghai. Welcome Dinner and reflections on Shanghai.
- ◇ April 15th: Visit local churches and a Christian bookstore. Meet with the president of the China Christian Council.
- ◇ April 16th: See the Jade Temple and the Underground Museum. History lesson and overview of Buddhism. Overnight train to Wuhan.
- ◇ April 17th: Attend services at Thanksgiving Church in Wuhan. Lunch at the church. Visit Christian coffee shop.
- ◇ April 18th: Visit the Lutheran Home and Agency and Zhongnan Seminary. Lunch with church leaders and seminary leadership.
- ◇ April 19th: Bullet train to Chongqing. Tour Dinner in Chongqing. Board the Century Star Cruise Ship.
- ◇ April 19th through April 22nd: Yangtze River Cruise. Visit sites along the way. Learn of several cultures within China. Visit the Three Gorges Dam complex. Disembark for bullet train to Xinyang City.
- ◇ April 23rd: Bus to Jigongshan (Rooster Mountain). Visit various Lutheran missionary-related historical sites on the mountain.
- ◇ April 24th: Attend services at Xindian Church, which was established by Anna Martinson in 1916. Bus to Lijiazhai Middle School to tour the CSV summer camp sites and facilities.
- ◇ April 25th: Visit Shuikoumiao Elementary School in the morning. Visit Tanggen Elementary School. Visit homes of primary school students. Bus to Xinyang City and hotel.
- ◇ April 26th: Tour Nan Guan Church designed by Daniel Nelson in 1906. Dinner with ESL teachers who will share about their work in China. Bullet train to Beijing.
- ◇ April 27th: Bus to Great Wall of China.
- ◇ April 28th: Free time in Beijing. Many activity options are available. Such as Tian'anmen Square and Forbidden City.
- ◇ April 29th Fly home.
